Get direct and confidential advice and clarification on all integration issues.

Consultation on health and family

Talk to specialists about family planning, pregnancy, sexuality and mental health.

Consultation on self-determination and prevention of violence

Talk to female law enforcement officers and staff from violence protection organisations about all forms of violence.

Expert seminars

Experts share information on work, education, training, health, violence, children and equal opportunities.

German language courses

Attend learning groups for mothers and reading groups for parents and children.

Excursions

Get to know important institutions and contact points together with other women.

Free counselling for migrant women

The ÖIF-Frauenzentrum is the Women's Centre of Österreichischer Integrationsfonds and the central point of contact for migrant women. It offers personal counselling, consulting hours and seminars on topics such as integration, education and training options, the labour market, health, self-determination, protection from violence and German language courses. The services are free of charge. Interpreters will be available as needed.
