

The coronavirus traffic light consists of four warning levels: "Green – Yellow – Orange – Red"<sup>2</sup>. The coronavirus traffic light gives an instant indication of the measures that have been put in place and the rules that have to be followed to limit the spread of coronavirus as much as possible.

In all traffic light phases, (digital) communication between teachers and parents/guardians is especially important!
